**Jack Thiele: Sep 12, 1934 - Jun 8, 2018**



**Jack Thiele:** Today's event commemorates a Suncoast Sandpiper who for almost 25 years played an indispensable role in the club's success. Throughout that time, he served as club officer, walk director, trail master, registration expert, checkpoint monitor and master roaster chef, greeting all with a friendly grin. He was a sterling exemplar for the AVA, America's Walking Club, and will be greatly missed on the trail and in our hearts. Those who knew him are asked to share a memory. **Location & Times:** Registration will be at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, 37623 Magnolia Ave. Start walk between 8-9:30 a.m. Finish by 12:30 p.m. Lunch will be served from 10:30-12:15.

**Directions:** From I-75, take exit 285, Dade City/SR 52 (becomes Meridian Ave. in Dade City). Go EAST about 9 miles to 11<sup>th</sup> St. LEFT on 11<sup>th</sup> St. Take first left to Magnolia Ave. Left on Magnolia Ave. to church on right. From US 98/301 Bypass, turn onto Howard Ave. to 11<sup>th</sup> St. RIGHT on 11<sup>th</sup> St. to Magnolia Ave. and LEFT to church on right. Parking is available in the church parking lot, Price Park across from the church and on streets around the church.



**The Walk:** Join Suncoast Sandpipers Volkssport Club in a easy (rated 1+) 5K (3.1 mile) or 10K ( 6.2 mile) walk of historic Dade City, Jack's home for many years. Participants follow written directions, strolling on city streets and on some unpaved trails. With some modifications of the route, strollers and wheelchairs will be okay. **Volkssports:** The Suncoast Sandpipers Volkssport Club is a member of the American Volkssport Association (AVA) and sponsors noncompetitive events called volkssports. Many participants keep track of their

distance and event achievements in record books by paying a small fee for volkssport credit. However it is not necessary to walk for credit. EVERYONE is invited! But if you're interested in volkssports, stop by the information table. **Please note:** The American Volkssport Association or its subsidiary clubs are not responsible for theft or loss of personal belongings or property. All participants must sign a waiver (adults for kids).

**Special Programs:** Today's walk is eligible for the following programs: Animal Safari, Bridges, Ice Cream Parlors, Make a Wish in a Water Fountain, Points of Reference, Post Offices, Take a Walk in a City Park, Treasure Hunt, United States Walk the USA, Street by Street, Walking the US, Walking the USA, A-Z. Check for updates at the start.

**Fees:** Basic walk fee is \$2. The AVA has sanctioned today's event, ID # 112173, as eligible for IVV achievement awards. Volkssport credit is an additional \$1. Lunch is \$7. Registration form is on page 4.
